# Dry Town Water Park Instructions, Directions, and Rules

Safety is everyone's responsibility. Inappropriate or unsafe behavior will not be tolerated and is subject to immediate removal from Dry Town Water Park.

All minor children must be accompanied by their parent or legal guardian.

**\*\*\*YOU MUST BE WEARING YOUR DRYTOWN WRISTBAND FOR ADMISSION AND LUNCH REPLACEMENTS WILL NOT BE AVAILABLE AT THE EVENT\*\*\***

**Check-in** is at the main entrance of the park and there is not set check-in time for our group. Please have your wristband on. Although the price is the same for the wristbands (over or under 48" is \$10 for ERA members and \$20 for guests) the wristbands are still different. The under 48" wristbands alert the staff to pay closer attention those guests, however, your height is still checked at each ride no matter what wristband you are wearing. Please buy the appropriate wristband for you, your family, and your guests.

**Food** will be delivered to me at our pavilion area at 1pm and will be available to be picked up for one hour thereafter. Each person must be present to receive meal. I will track meals issued and to save time I will give ALL meals to the ERA member for their whole family. It is too difficult to track individually. You don't have to come as a group; just the ERA member must be present to get all meals for his/her group. Parents/guardians please accompany your smaller children during meal time.

**Rules** for the park are as follows:

- Guests must be at least 42 inches tall to ride Big Rock River without adult supervision. Guests under 42 inches may use Big Rock River with adult supervision provided on a one-to-one ratio.
- Guests must be at least 36 inches tall to use Little Miner's Camp without adult supervision. Guests under 36 inches may use Little Miner's Camp with adult supervision provided on a one-to-one ratio.
- Dry Town is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- Some attractions will close during inclement weather. (Rain, lightning and thunderstorms or wind above 40 MPH)
- For guest protection, use of recording devices (cameras/video cameras) and cell phone is strictly prohibited in restrooms and locker area. Video camera's are prohibited throughout the water park.
- Photographers are occasionally employed by the City to take photos for promotional purposes. Entrance grants consent for your photo to be used in promotional material.
- Patrons are responsible for their own safety in the park. Rowdy behavior and excessive horseplay may lead to serious accidents and are prohibited.
- Re-entry permitted with admission receipt or hand stamp.
- Pregnant women & persons with heart conditions or back trouble should not use the slides or the river.
- For the benefit & safety of guests. Dry Town reserves the right to restrict any guest from using any ride for inappropriate conduct.
- Please follow rules provided by lifeguards.
- No Running and no diving.
- No outside flotation devices are allowed. Inner tubes and life jackets are provided free of charge.
- No outside food, drink, or tobacco is permitted in Dry Town.
- Individuals are permitted to carry one bottle of water into the park. No bulk packs of water will be permitted. A small personal size cooler is permitted with water only.
- Appropriate attire, behavior and language are required. Inappropriate behavior, language or vulgar attire unsuitable for a family environment will be grounds for refusing admission or removal from the park without a refund.
- Dress Code: Traditional swimwear is required. No provocative or thong swimsuits. Street clothes, cut-offs, snaps, buttons, rivets, belts and metal ornamentation are not allowed. Please remember that this is a family-oriented facility. Dress appropriately.
- Diapered guests must wear approved plastic swim diaper cover, which can be purchased at cost in Dry Town's General Store. Disposable swim diapers (such as Little Swimmers) of any kind cannot be substituted for a swim diaper/cover.
- Swim shoes are not permitted on any slide. However, guests are encouraged to wear them while walking the grounds of the park.
- Guests must be at least 48 inches tall to ride any of the large slides (Rattler's Revenge, Devil's Punch Bowl and The Wildcatter).
- Guests must be at least 42 inches tall to ride Dusty's Mineshaft Racer.
- Goggles may be worn in the park. However, no swim masks. Nothing that covers the nose. Goggles that cover the eyes only are permitted.
