Attention all ERA members:

It has been brought to my attention that Regal and AMC theaters may ask you to pay an additional upcharge when you use the movie ticket you purchased from the ERA office.

I have spoken to the theater's management and was told that at the beginning of this year an upcharge was approved in New York and California theaters. This charge may range from \$1.50-\$8.50 depending on what type of movie you are seeing, what day you are seeing it, what time you are seeing it, even in some cases what seat or section of the theater you are sitting in.

It seems that this upcharge is not consistently enforced since I have used my AMC ticket at the La Jolla Villa 12 theater and have never been charged with an up fee.

So, I am notifying all our members that you may be charged an upcharge in addition to the regular ticket you purchased through our offices.

I apologize to our ERA members who have purchased tickets from our offices without being told about this new upcharge.

Our ticket prices are still lower than paying full price at the box office in most cases.
