► **East End Adventure** - Climb into a unique, open-air, biofuel H1 Hummer or Unimog for an unforgettable 2 hour tour to the summit above Avalon. Traveling to 1,500 feet above sea level, you'll enjoy a birds-eye view of romantic Catalina Island and the ocean beyond.

► **Skyline Drive Tour** - This rousing, narrated journey along the scenic "Skyline Drive" takes you ten miles into Catalina Island's protected wilderness area on a 1950's Flxible Bus. You'll see spectacular vistas, deep canyons, quiet coves, an endless blue ocean, and even bison on this 2 hour and 15 minute tour.

► **Undersea Expedition** - Come face-to-face with Catalina's abundant marine life by cruising five feet under water in a spacious, climate-controlled cabin. Every passenger has their own seat and port hole, plus you're free to roam about the cabin to seek other viewpoints. Each expedition lasts approximately 45 minutes.

► **Bison Expedition** - Climb aboard an open-air biofuel Hummer and go in search of Catalina's American Bison on this exciting 4-wheeling expedition. Descendants of a small bison herd left on the island by a movie crew in the 1920s, have grown to about 150 and are managed by the Catalina Island Conservancy.

Bison Expedition takes you into the heart of Catalina's rugged wilderness. You'll pass through Middle Ranch, before heading up Cape Canyon to a scenic overlook on Black Jack Mountain. And then it's down the original 19th-century stagecoach route back to Avalon. Along the way, your guide will share interesting facts about the island's history as you journey through favorite bison grazing grounds, where you'll have an excellent opportunity to see these majestic animals in the wild. It's a unique experience you'll only find on Catalina Island.



► **Zip Line Eco Tour** - Propel down 5 separate zip lines up to 1,100 feet long, from heights as great as 600 feet above sea level, and speeds up to 40mph. Your journey will last approximately 2 hours, and your memories will last a lifetime.

► **Glass Bottom Boat Voyage** - We've been taking curious Catalina visitors on journeys of discovery into Lover's Cove Marine Preserve for nearly a century.
