GENERAL ATOMICS BIBLE CLUB 2024 MEMBERSHIP FORM

ARTICLE II. OBJECTIVES AND ORIENTATION

The purposes of this club include the following:

1. To study the Bible.
2. To promote the normal understanding of the words of scripture in their historical context, and their contemporary application through the systematic reading and inductive study of the old and new testaments of the Bible.
3. To promote biblical fellowship.
4. To encourage one another in biblical living, i.e. in love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control, as listed in Galatians 5:22 & 23.
5. To pray for the needs of all the club members and for the company management (I Timothy 2:1, 2).
6. To provide an appropriate forum for the presentation and/or discussion of particular issues of interest to the club through films, guest speakers, etc.

Theological Orientation

The theological orientation of the General Atomics Bible Club presumes:

1. The Bible is the fully inspired and infallible word of God
2. The Trinity—The eternally existing Triune God: the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit
3. Jesus Christ is the only begotten Son of God, fully God and fully man
4. Salvation by grace through faith in the atoning death and resurrection of Jesus Christ

ARTICLE III. MEMBERSHIP

Section 1. Eligibility

All regular employees of General Atomics, its subsidiaries and affiliates, and retirees of General Atomics, and employees on the General Atomics Mesa are eligible for membership, regardless of theological orientation.

Club members must be ERA members in good standing for the Bible Club to be eligible to receive ERA allotment funds for said members.

Section 2. Member

A member is one who has applied for membership, has been accepted, is current in his/her club dues and does not persist in promoting denominational differences at club activities.
